

'twas the empty tomb of Christ my Lord who lives.'


3. 'Then I saw the glory of the risen Lord,

That love should dwell in each, in all.

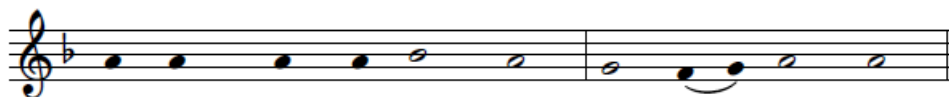
